On Mondays and Fridays, the sacks are packed extra full with items like granola bars, cheese crackers and trail mix that can help over the weekends for those without reliable meals.

The Foodbank has provided a variety of juices, water, tea and Kool-Aid to offer in addition to an overflowing sack of food each day.

Several people were involved in a run to north Arkansas to pick up a donation of 8 cases of Little Debbie Snack cakes for special dessert treats for our diners.
