

Our Mission

The primary mission of the Stewpot is to Feed the Hungry - "Feed whoever walks through our doors". The Stewpot is open from 12:00 to 1:00 p.m. Monday through Friday of each week providing a hot meal to the homeless, jobless, elderly, physically or mentally disabled and displaced families in the Greater Little Rock area. The Little Rock Stewpot has served over 1.5 million meals in the last 45 years.

Little Rock Stewpot Receives AGS Award

On March 14, 2018, the Little Rock Stewpot received the Outstanding Volunteer Group Award from the Arkansas Gerontological Society at its Spring Conference at the C.A. Vines Arkansas 4-H Center in Little Rock. Charlie Frith, Stewpot Board Chairman; Herb Rule, Stewpot Board Member; and Charlotte Frith, Stewpot Team Co-Captain represented the Stewpot for the award ceremony. Herb Rule and Charlie Frith accepted the award from Carol Enderlin, outgoing president of AGS. They received a plaque and a check for \$250.





Stewpot Food Ordering Update

The Stewpot has been ordering more and more food from the Arkansas Food Bank primarily through the help of Nancy Howell and Kay Shurgar, both Stewpot Board members. Ordering food from the Arkansas



Food Bank is saving the Stewpot \$1,000 per month. Not only are we saving but providing our diners with fresh fruit and vegetables, great meat and lots of extra treats. For the year of 2017, the Stewpot served 40,538 diners at a total food cost of \$59,010. The cost per meal was \$1.45. This is a savings of almost \$1.00 per meal compared to 2016. 2018 CAPACITY BUILDING GRANTS AWARDED TO HUNGER RELIEF AGENCIES ACROSS ARKANSAS


LITTLE ROCK, AR (March 13, 2018) — The Arkansas Hunger Relief Alliance has just finished awarding more than \$188,000 in capacity building grants to hunger relief agencies around the state. The grants will help food banks, pantries, shelter, soup kitchens and other agencies increase their ability to

serve the food insecure in their communities. Funds for the grants are provided through the State Food Purchase Program of the Arkansas Legislature.

Capacity building grants may be used to purchase appliances such as refrigerators, freezers, and stoves as well shelving, trailers, computers other equipment that will help feed more food insecure people. Grant dollars may not be used for salaries or personnel.

The Little Rock Stewpot received a grant from the Arkansas Hunger Alliance to buy a new stainless steel refrigerator. Thanks, Arkansas Hunger Alliance
