AR Hunger Relief Alliance Annual Membership Meeting and Conference

A ballroom full of people from all over the state gathered for AR Hunger Relief Alliance annual membership meeting and conference Thursday September 12 in downtown Little Rock. The meeting was sponsored by Arkansas BlueCross BlueShield who has made reducing hunger in AR a priority.

Charlie Frith and Nancy Howell, Stewpot Board members, were among those attending. Kathy Webb, AHRA Director, gave the yearly report of what the Hunger Relief Alliance has been doing. They have been doing an unbelievable amount sharing ideas and information to help all types of programs around the state.

Next we were informed by speakers and workshops on topics ranging from Homelessness and Hunger to writing Mini-Grants to Gleaning and Gardening for Hunger Relief.

After lunch the Keynote speaker Dr. Eduardo Ochoa from Arkansas Children's Hospital provided an eye-opening talk on Food Insecurity driving up health care costs in an astronomical way. He said SNAP works like a vaccine and it is a booster shot for further development for children and families.
